WHEREAS, These officers risk their lives every day to protect our communities and their bravery and selfless services shall not be overlooked by a grateful nation and

WHEREAS, Across the United States, the week of May 12th through 18th 2019, will be recognized as "National Police Week"; and

WHEREAS, The first "National Peace Officers' Memorial Day" was held on May 15, 1982, following a proclamation signed by President John F. Kennedy on October 1, 1961, and has continued to be observed annually in memory of those police officers who made the ultimate sacrifice in the line of duty; and
