### **Greentree—The Main Line Town That Never Happened** **Wednesday, January 15th at 7:00 p.m.**



The communities of the Main Line were created when small towns sprang up at each railroad stop along the Pennsylvania Railroad's "main line". But one such community never quite made it: Greentree in Willistown Township between Paoli and Malvern. Come hear local historian and long time Greentree resident

Bart Van Valkenburgh speak on the little town that couldn't, and explore the history of roads, taverns, and trains and how they all influenced development along the Main Line.

Bart serves as a board member of several local history groups including The Paoli Battlefield Preservation Fund, The Tredyffrin Easttown Historical Society (TEHS), and the Willistown Historical Commission. His slideshow includes old photos found in the TEHS archive showing 1930's pictures of Greentree.

All programs are held at the Newtown Township Building, 209 Bishop Hollow Rd, Newtown Square, PA 19073 beginning at 7:00 p.m. Admission is free. Refreshments are served.
