Bottles and jugs (#1-5 & 7)



CANS

Aluminum and steel



NEWSPAPER

Clean, dry and no food contact



CARDBOARD

Clean, dry and no food contact



GLASS

Bottles and jars



CARTONS

Clean, dry and no food contact

Unacceptable Materials

- × Plastic bags
- × Food/liquid
- × Garden hoses
- × Clothing/shoes
- × Diapers
- × Medical waste
- × Scrap metal
- × Polystyrene foam

When in doubt, throw it out!

Newtown Township Recycles!

Residential Single-Stream Recycling Collections occur from each home twice every month.



Collections begin at 7:00 AM on recycling day, so be sure to have your materials out early (preferably the night before) to be sure you do not miss the truck.

We collect “single stream” – so all of your materials can be placed out together for pick up! Place them **loose** in your cart – plastic / trash bags cannot be used.

Remember – there is no recycling pickup when there is a 5th day of the month. Recycling days that fall on holidays will be collected the following day.

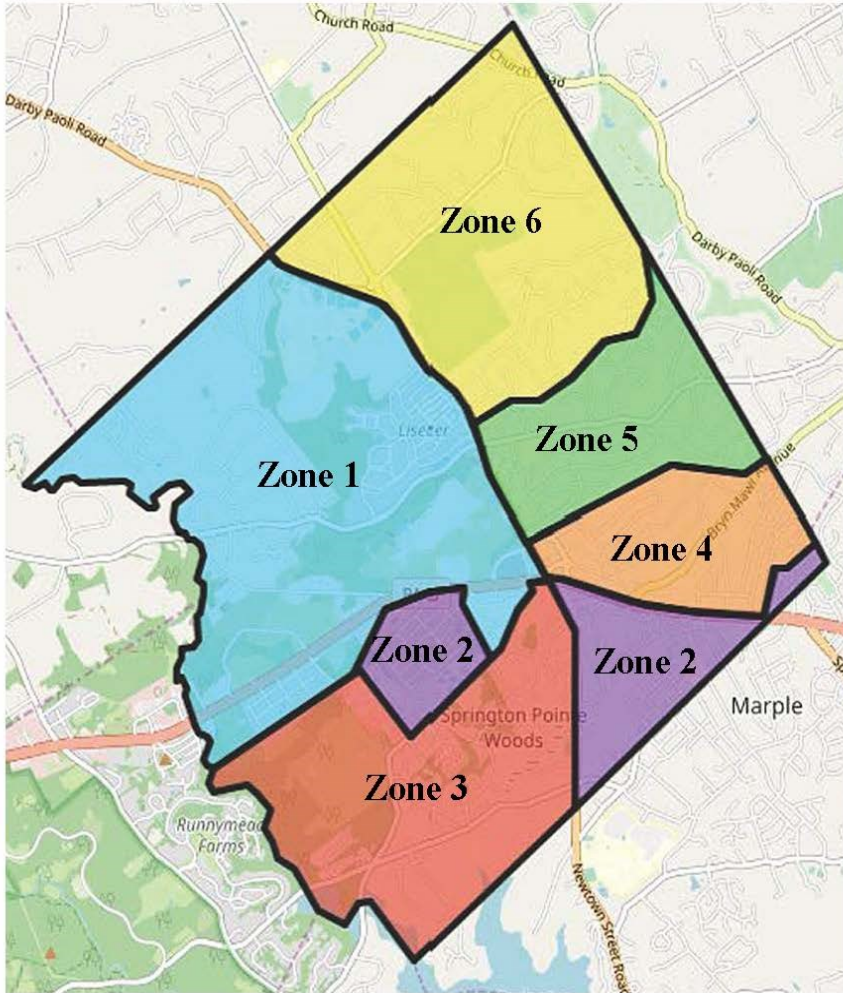
