



## Resolution No. 2017 - 10

### A RESOLUTION OF NEWTOWN TOWNSHIP DELAWARE COUNTY, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING THE NEWTOWN TOWNSHIP EMERGENCY OPERATIONS PLAN (EOP)

**WHEREAS**, the Newtown Emergency Operations Plan (EOP) was adopted to coordinate emergency services in Newtown Township in the event of a hazards, emergencies or disasters in accordance with the Pennsylvania Emergency Management Services Code; and

**WHEREAS**, the Section entitled "Direction and Coordination" indicates "Upon disaster declaration by the President of the Board of Commissioners..."; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Supervisors of Newtown Township, by this resolution, amends the EOP in order to make the language consistent with government official titles and to amend the declaration of disaster decision process.

**NOW THEREFORE**, the Board of Supervisors of Newtown Township does hereby resolve as follows:

1. The Newtown Emergency Operations Plan (EOP) is amended to change the titles throughout the Plan from "President, Vice President and Board of Commissioners" to "Chairman, Vice-Chairman, and Board of Supervisors ; and
2. The first sentence of Paragraph A of "Direction and Coordination" is deleted and the following sentence is added, "Upon disaster declaration by the majority vote of the Township Manager, Township Director of Public Works and the Police Chief, the Board of Supervisors is responsible for the protection and safety of the public in Newtown Township and will exercise direction and control of its emergency management agency and response activities within Newtown Township.
