

## RESOLUTION 2017-36 Emergency Operations Plan

WHEREAS, Section 7503 of the Pennsylvania Emergency Management Services Code, 35 Pa. C.S. Section 7101 et seq. mandates that Newtown Township prepare, maintain and keep current an emergency operations plan for the prevention and minimization of injury and damage caused by a major emergency or disaster within this Township; and

**WHEREAS,** in response to the mandate stated above, Newtown Township has prepared an emergency operations plan to provide prompt and effective emergency response procedures to be followed in the event of a major emergency or disaster; and

**WHEREAS,** Newtown Township has also prepared an emergency operations plan in order to reduce the potential effects of a major emergency or disaster and to protect the health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Township;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED we, the undersigned Supervisors of Newtown Township do hereby approve and adopt the state endorsed emergency preparedness plan as the foundation of Newtown Township's plan with the understanding that the appendices and annexes will be kept up to date by the emergency manager coordinator and place into immediate affect into the Emergency Operations Plan of Newtown Township. This plan shall be reviewed every two years to make certain that it conforms with the requirements of the Delaware County Emergency Operations Guideline.
