**RESOLUTION NO. 2017- 37**

**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF NEWTOWN TOWNSHIP,  
DELAWARE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING THE TOWNSHIP'S 2013  
OFFICIAL SEWAGE FACILITIES PLAN UPDATE (ACT 537 PLAN) FOR THE CRUM  
CREEK BASIN OF THE TOWNSHIP (SEWER DISTRICT 3).**

**WHEREAS**, Section 5 of the Act of January 24, 1966, P.L. 1535, No. 537, known as the "Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act," as amended, and the Rules and Regulations of the Department of Environmental Protection ("Department") adopted there under, Chapter 71 of Title 25 of the Pennsylvania Code, requires Newtown Township (the "Township") to adopt an Official Sewage Facilities Plan ("Act 537 Plan") providing for sewage services adequate to prevent contamination of waters and/or environmental health hazards with sewage wastes, and to revise said plan whenever it is necessary to meet the sewage disposal needs of the municipality; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township, in 2013 adopted an Act 537 Plan Update for properties located within the Crum Creek Basin of the Township, which was approved by the Department on September 24, 2013 ("2013 Plan Update"); and

**WHEREAS**, Bradford Engineering Associates, Inc. has prepared a Minor Act 537 Plan Revision, entitled *EDGMONT TOWNSHIP NEWTOWN TOWNSHIP DELAWARE COUNTY ROUTE 252 COMMON FORCE MAIN COMPONENT 3m MINOR ACT 537 PLAN UPDATE REVISION, dated August 2017* (the "Minor Act 537 Plan Revision"), a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof as Exhibit "A", which proposes to amend the 2013 Plan Update to designate the use of an existing 10" common force main located in Route 252 in Newtown Township, Delaware County, to collect and convey sanitary sewage flows from Edgmont Township's Crum Creek Sewer District to the collection and conveyance lines of the Central Delaware County Authority for ultimate treatment and disposal by the Delaware County Regional Water Control Authority; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township finds that the Minor Act 537 Plan Revision conforms to applicable zoning, subdivision, other Township ordinances and plans and to a comprehensive program of pollution control and water quality management.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Newtown hereby adopts and submits to the Department for its approval as a revision to the Township's 2013 Plan Update, the above referenced Minor Act 537 Plan Revision; and



**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, the Township hereby assures the Department of the complete and timely implementation of the said plan as required by law (Section 5, Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act as amended).
