**WHEREAS**, Across the United States, the week of May 13<sup>th</sup> through 19<sup>th</sup> 2018, will be recognized as "National Police Week"; and

**WHEREAS**, The first "National Peace Officers' Memorial Day" was held on May 15, 1982, following a proclamation signed by President John F. Kennedy on October 1, 1961, and has continued to be observed annually in memory of those police officers who made the ultimate sacrifice in the line of duty; and

**WHEREAS**, That the Senate honor the memory of the hundreds of police officers who have given their lives in the line of duty in this Commonwealth; and

**WHEREAS**, That the Senate recognize the week of May 13<sup>th</sup> through 19<sup>th</sup>, 2018, as "National Police Week", and May 15, 2018, as "Peace Officers Memorial Day" in Pennsylvania.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, The Board of Supervisors of the Township of Newtown does hereby acknowledge May 13<sup>th</sup> through 19<sup>th</sup>, 2018 as National Police Week, and May 15, 2018, as Peace Officers Memorial Day in Pennsylvania.


