ORDINANCE 2016-03

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NEWTOWN, DELAWARE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING SECTIONS 165.12 BY DELETING AND RESERVING FOR FUTURE USE AND SECTION 165.13A BY DELECTING SUBSECTION 2, 11, 29 AND ADD SUBSECTION 2, 11 AND AMENDING SECTION 165.13B BY DELETING AND RESERVING FOR FUTURE USE AND SUBSECTION 165.13E BY DELETING AND RESERVING FOR FUTURE USE TO THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NEWTOWN PROVIDING FOR NO PARKING SIGNS.

The Board of Supervisors of the Township of Newtown does hereby ordain that the codified Ordinances of the Township of Newtown are hereby amended as follows:

Section 1.

Article II. Section 165.12 (Overnight Parking) of the Codified Ordinances is hereby amended as by deleting the following:

No person shall park or permit a vehicle to stand within the limits of any public highway of the Township between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. local time.

Article II. Section 165.12 (Overnight Parking) of the Codified Ordinances is hereby amended as by adding the following:

Reserved for Future Use

Article II. Section 165.13 (Specific Parking Restrictions) of the Codified Ordinances is hereby amended as by deleting the following:

A. Prohibitions at all times. No person shall park or permit a vehicle to stand in those sections or zones of the following highways of the Township as are hereinafter set forth:

2. Both sides of Munger Road from Newtown Street Road to Clyde Lane.

(11) The west side of Clyde Lane from the north side curbline adjacent to the paved roadway of the West Chester Pike northerly for a distance of 272 feet.

(29) The east side of Clyde Lane commencing at a point 187 feet from the north side curbline adjacent to the paved roadway of West Chester Pike northerly to Munger Lane.

B. Maximum 30 minutes. No person shall park or permit a vehicle to stand for a period of more than 30 minutes in those sections or zones of the following highways of the Township as are hereinafter set forth:

(1) East side of Clyde Lane from West Chester Pike to Munger Road.

E. No parking 2:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. to 6:30 p.m.; maximum 30 minutes 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. and 6:30 p.m. or park or permit a vehicle to stand for more than 30 minutes between the hours 10:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. in that section or zone of the following highway of the Township:

- (1) The west side of Clyde Lane commencing at a point 272 feet from the north side curblin adjacent to the paved roadway of the West Chester Pike northerly to the terminus of Clyde Lane.

Article II. Section 165.13 (Specific Parking Restrictions) of the Codified Ordinances is hereby amended as by adding the following:

A. Prohibitions at all times. No person shall park or permit a vehicle to stand in those sections or zones of the following highways of the Township as are hereinafter set forth:

- (2) North side of Munger Road from Newtown Street Road to Clyde Lane.

- (11) Both sides of Clyde Lane from West Chester Pike to Winding Way Road.

B. Maximum 30 minutes. No person shall park or permit a vehicle to stand for a period of more than 30 minutes in those sections or zones of the following highways of the Township as are hereinafter set forth:

RESERVED FOR FUTURE USE

E. No parking 2:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. to 6:30 p.m.; maximum 30 minutes 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. No person shall park or permit a vehicle to stand between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 10:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. and 6:30 p.m. or park or permit a vehicle to stand for more than 30 minutes between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. in that section or zone of the following highway of the Township:

RESERVED FOR FUTURE USE

Section 2. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be effective upon its adoption by The Township of Newtown.

Section 3. Repealer. All ordinances, resolutions or parts thereof inconsistent herewith are repealed, rescinded, canceled and annulled to the extent of such inconsistency.
