



TOWNSHIP OF NEWTOWN

ORDINANCE 2018-1

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NEWTOWN, DELAWARE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING the Codified Ordinances of Newtown Township, Chapter 165, Vehicles and Traffic, Article I, Section 165-1 Stop Intersections Designated, Article II, Section 165-11 Parking and Standing Restrictions and Article II, Section 165-13, Specific Parking Restrictions.

The Board of Supervisors of the Township of Newtown does hereby ordain that the codified Ordinances of the Township of Newtown are hereby amended as follows:

Article I, Section 165-1, Stop Intersections Designated.

The following intersections are hereby designated as stop intersections, the second-named highways or streets being hereby designated as through highways or streets:

D (13) - North on Morton Street at First Avenue.

Article II, Section 165-11, Parking and Standing Restrictions

A. No person shall park a vehicle or permit it to stand, whether attended or unattended, upon a highway in any of the following places:

(15) At any place where temporary official signs have been erected by the Newtown Township Police Department, prohibiting parking for a specific time period, with seven (7) days posted notice, for street paving or other Township business or activities. The Newtown Police Department is authorized to have any vehicle parked during the restricted time period to be towed by a towing service with all towing and storage expenses to be paid by the registered owner of the vehicle.

Article II, Section 165-13, Specific Parking Restrictions.

A. Prohibitions at all times. No person shall park or permit a vehicle to stand in those sections or zones of the following highways of the Township as are hereinafter set forth:

(9) (a) Both sides of Bishop Hollow Road from West Chester Pike to Hollow Road.

(b) North side of Bishop Hollow Road from Hollow Road to Wisteria Drive.

C. Maximum two hours. No person shall park or permit a motor vehicle to stand for a period of more than two hours in those sections or zones of the following highways of the Township as are hereinafter set forth:

(4) East side of St. Albans Avenue from St. Albans Circle to Woodcrest Avenue.

Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be effective upon its adoption by the Township of Newtown.

Repealer. All ordinances, resolutions or parts thereof inconsistent herewith, are repealed, rescinded, canceled and annulled to the extent of such inconsistency.
